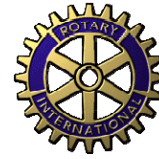
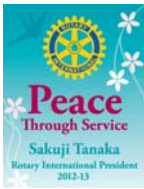

- ❖ The slogan for Canadian Cancer is “To eradicate cancer and to enhance the lives of those of whom are living with Cancer”
- ❖ There are over 200 types of cancers
- ❖ Research / Advocacy / Information & Support / Prevention
- ❖ Sherry showed us a video that was produced in BC “Children with Cancer”
- ❖ NB is part clinical trials
- ❖ Camp Goodtime in NB which is held at Camp Rotary in the summer
- ❖ Relay for Life: are in the midst of organizing a Dream Team
- ❖ Lou @ CJCW will support this event
- ❖ This is a challenge similar to what Woodstock had one in the past
- ❖ Chairs would be placed on a roof / building in Sussex – there would be tents, port a potties etc.
- ❖ “Fools on the Roof”
- ❖ For every \$2 donation would keep these people that have volunteer on the roof for 1 minute
- ❖ This year is the 10th anniversary for Relay for Life in Sussex
- ❖ There are approx.200 hundred survivors that walk the track
- ❖ JJ’s have offered a meal for the survivors this year
- ❖ The would like to create a Dream Team, which would be made up of local people
- ❖ They have 4-5 people committed to the event
- ❖ Goal for each person would be \$1,000
