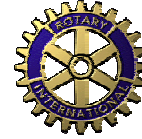

Mike also talked about Shelter Box, he is the Shelter Box rep for NB and supports them 100%. Mike was very excited to tell us about the Shelter Box "Tent City" that their club is having in Moncton this spring for the public and Rotarians to come and see what it is all about. 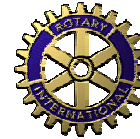
Kim is sending an email to follow up on the letters sent out for the event. The letters were sent on the 20th of November.
