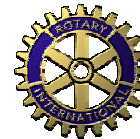

Rotary Minute – Robert L. did the Rotary Minute. His minute was about Classification. He described what it means and the importance to a member’s classification in Rotary. Every member knew their own classification but may not know the classification of their fellow members. It was suggested and agreed that we should have our classification on our new name tags/badge when we order them.

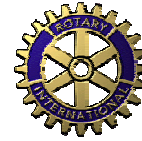
Guest Speaker – Bob and Jeanette were both in and ready for a great presentation to help explain what they are doing in Africa. They had a great slide show as well as several statistics about the entire mission and all aspects of the trip in general.

Africa has close to 1 billion people, 12.6 million of which are in Zambia, 1 Million of the 12.6 are orphans because of Aids. In Zambia English is the primary language. Mining is a big part of the industry/economy. They are the 4th largest miner of copper in the world. Zambia is famous for Victoria Falls. Mwandzi, a village of 7,500 people, has 1100 orphans. Bob is going to help with building huts and Jeanette will work at a local hospital. Bob gave out a handout with information on the mission and the cost to build huts and would be happy to provide you with one if you were unable to attend. They have a building for “OVC” (orphans & vulnerable children) and 100 children attend each day. The goal of this Ma & Pa mission is to build 24 huts per year. There are four main projects for the United Church of Zambia Mission so they have a lot to do. Paula and Dan Vanzyl have been there on behalf of this mission since 2004 and are going to be there to host Bob & Jeanette.

Bob asked our club to support their mission with a donation of \$1,000. This will build more than one large two room hut.

He researched and it does not look like we can get any funding from District or RI (matching or otherwise).

Our Club has \$1200 in the Budget for International projects that has not been spent. This is listed under the budget as “World Community Service Projects”.



Bob Kimball Sr. made a motion to support Bob & Jeanette's mission with a \$1,000 donation from the clubs "World Community Service Projects" budget to go towards building huts in Zambia. This was seconded by Wendy Osborne and passed by the club.

Lou – Trip Draw Tickets – Tickets had to be passed in by midnight on the 15th to be in the early bird draw on the 16th. Note: We may need to give more time for processing in the future and have the ticket state a deadline of 24 or more hours prior to the early bird draw. Just a suggestion.

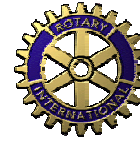

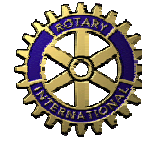
