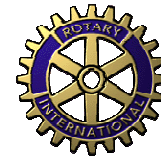

Robert T. chaired the meeting and introduced our guest.

Bruce & Rhoda work together. He is the facilitator for Community Living, they work with people who are intellectually disabled and their job is to integrate them into the community. Bruce gave a great slide show on the community living division. Their objective is to help make a “PATH” where people with intellectual disabilities can work in the public like everyone else. Lou mentioned the lack of a buddy system in the high school compared to elementary and middle school when his son went to the high school and he asked when they might be able to continue the “buddy system” throughout the entire school system. Bruce confirmed that they are working on it now and typically they have to concentrate on the youth in the younger levels as a priority out of necessity because that is the most crucial area. They have an agenda but are limited where they can devote the system and have to chose the youth first and admits that there are challenges with that approach.

Member Pins (Name Tags) – Lou passed the sample of the template around and the pins themselves look great and we made a few suggestions to improve the size of the Names without sacrificing the classifications.
