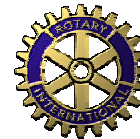

Paul Introduced Pam Harrison, our Guest Speaker for the meeting. Pam drove all the way from Amherst to talk to us about Paul Harris Fellow & the Paul Harris Society. Pam is very passionate about the Paul Harris Society and Rotary in general. Paul Harris is our founder and we are now the oldest and largest service club in the world. The Rotary Foundation started in 1917 and the first donation made was for \$26.50 (a rather large donation in it's time). Easter Seals was the first charity supported at that time. Paul Harris passed away in 1947 and in 1957 on the tenth anniversary of his death Archie Clump started the Paul Harris Society. Pam gave a great and informative slideshow with details and statistics on the PHF and the PH Society.
