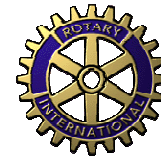

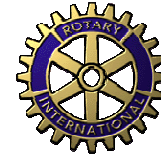

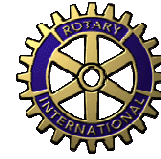

Budget & Bank Account Status

- The Club's general account which we use for dues, meals, web site etc. has \$5,225 & a cheque to be cashed for \$1,000 for paid dues. We invoiced for \$1,500 so we still have dues outstanding to be paid to the club. We have liabilities from this account for \$883 district dues and \$10 for the All Seasons. = **\$5,332**
- As of September 1st the Trip Draw account had \$62,812 plus \$1,000 to be paid from automatic withdrawals and \$2,100 in post dated cheques that will be added to the account once the dates are due. We have \$6,400 in trips that have been won and \$20,750 for future trip draw payouts. We also have to pay \$275 for the lotto license, \$200 to the record and \$280 to CJCW leaving a balance of **\$37,996** once the liabilities and future payouts are calculated.
- Charitable Trust Account which we use for Coats for Kids, Bursaries and other charitable organizations has \$6,044 + \$200 o/s for unpaid dinner tickets less \$2,000 due to be paid in bursaries. = **\$4,244**

Barb will be emailing a copy of the budget to all the chairs to give them a chance to review the budget and add their thoughts regarding their assignment and we will be presenting the budget to the membership to be passed in the very near future.

Civic Centre – Robert L suggested that we really should try and pay the Civic Centre off ASAP in order to move on to our next worthy cause and agenda. Harley will be meeting with them and will be mentioning the “Rotary Room”. He would like to see us have a spot to place our plaques in the eye of the public. Harley will bring a report back to the club next Monday.

Robert is going to contact the Civic Centre to get the details on the balance and due dates for the remainder of the commitment.

November 7th, 2011 meeting – We will be having a special guest and dinner on the 7th and we will be emailing the membership to determine the numbers prior to the dinner. We will be having turkey.

Elvis concert presented by the Hampton Rotary Club – Robert and Juanita Tremblett went to the concert at the Hampton High and said that the Elvis impersonator / tribute entertainer was outstanding and the crowd was approximately 600 people. He felt the fundraiser went really well.
